RODEO SCHEDULE

***Weds. September 2-6:30 pm HS performance, slack to follow for HS & WD**

***Thurs. September 3-11:30 am slack, 6:30 pm WD performance, slack to follow for HS & WD**

***Fri. September 4-6:30 pm performance-HS only**

-Contestants are NOT allowed to enter the grounds prior to Wednesday!

-All contestants will receive 1 free gate admission. Everyone else will need to pay gate fee of \$11 **OR** advanced ticket sales at CUB Foods Store for \$9, prior to August 27.

-Each member's family will receive one free dry camping lot. Trailer parking will be assigned by State Fair officials. **NO** saving spots, awnings **OR** GENERATORS BETWEEN midnight & 6:00am.

-Unload horses in the trailer parking area, **ALL horses must be stalled MANDATORY!** Tie stalls are FREE in the Horse Annex building, or \$10 box stalls. (details later) You can bring your own bedding or buy at the fairgrounds, stalls **MUST** be bedded!

-Exercise ring (hoop arena) is available for warm up arena.

-No riding in any barns & no horses permitted past the coliseum.

-Showers available

-ALL Performance & slack will be held in the coliseum

-RODEO admission is FREE to all!
